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UK Hydraulics and Pneumatics Sales 12/12 % Change

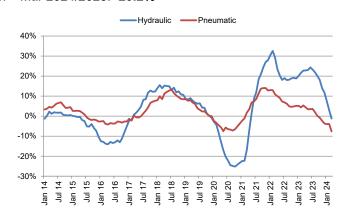

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Current Issues Facing BFPA Members (June 2024)

Positives

- Orders showing a positive trend in Q4 & into 2025
- Inflation down from 11% to 2.3%
- High wage rise demands softened
- UK manufacturing output improving, but very slowly
- UK GDP up from a forecast of 0.3% to 0.9%
- CE marking extended indefinitely (UKCA)
- Interest rates expected to be reduced late 2024
- · Lead-times & supply chain improved

Challenges

- · Higher interest rates
- Banks much more cautious on lending
- · Russia's continued invasion of Ukraine
- · Israel's war with Hamas
- · Oil, gas, energy & food prices remaining high
- · Skills shortage driving up salaries
- 890,000 UK job vacancies 60,000 in manufacturing
- · Global political uncertainty
- PFAS
- CBAM

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
